OHIO VALLEY GOODWILL ANNOUNCES 2022 TITLE SPONSOR FOR PIGABILITIES

For the sixth consecutive year, Ohio Valley Goodwill is delighted to announce that the organization will be the Title Sponsor of the 2022 PigAbilities event as part of the annual Flying Pig Marathon. PigAbilities this year will be the first time in two years, that an in-person event has taken place in downtown Cincinnati as part of the Flying Pig Marathon, due to the health risks of the pandemic. PigAbilities is designed to welcome athletes of all abilities who wish to be fully included in the weekend Cincinnati Flying Pig Marathon and represents the culmination of training efforts for months prior to the event.

Since the beginning of the New Year, Goodwill along with Pig Works, Hamilton County Developmental Disabilities Services and Paycor have been working together to try to get the word out about PigAbilities and ensure that all interested athletes have the ability to participate. This has included outreach efforts to increase participation as well as to offer assistance with registration, transportation and other related support needs. PigAbilities athletes typically participate in the event with the support of a coach they have been training with for months beforehand, working on fitness, nutrition and related health goals.

Goodwill will also be presenting its popular Pig Pop Up Shop on Friday, April 29th and Saturday, April 30th as a featured exhibitor during the Flying Pig Marathon Expo at the Duke Energy Center. The Pig Pop Up Shop will be stocked with an assortment of running and athleisure wear for all members of the family. Team Goodwill will be not only welcoming Expo goers to the Goodwill Pop Up Shop but also, participating in the weekend running events. As a long time sponsor of the PigAbilities event as part of the Cincinnati Flying Pig Marathon, Ohio Valley Goodwill is very much looking

I also welcome the customers to the store" reported John proudly about his job duties. John's Supervisor at work adores John and wishes he had other employees who were as enthusiastic as John.

When asked about the impact of working on John's life and future plans, he shared the following: "I am planning on saving the money I make at work so that I can buy things that I want like new clothes.
